

Please read the following requirements  
before signing up

Kansas requirements:

- 21 years of age;
- A citizen of the United States, a permanent resident alien or an eligible non-immigrant alien;
- A resident of the State of Kansas with a valid driver's license or state-issued identification card, or residing in Kansas while serving on active duty in the military; and
- A resident of the county where applying.

**Applicants may not be:**

- A fugitive from justice.
- Under charges or indictment for a felony or any other offense that could result in a prison term of more than one year.
- Convicted in court of a felony, or any other crime, for which the sentence could be imprisonment for more than one year.
- Convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
- Subject to a court order restraining from harassing, stalking or threatening a child, intimate partner or the child of an intimate partner.
- Arrested, convicted, addicted or unlawfully using controlled substances, including marijuana or any other depressant, stimulant or narcotic drugs.
- Adjudicated mental defect or committed to a mental institution.
- Discharged from the armed forces under dishonorable conditions.
- Renounced U.S. citizens.
- Illegally or unlawfully residing in the United States.
